Campground Information

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1. Youth groups are required to camp in the Pine Ridge Campground, Sites 20 - 24.

Sites will be assigned by park staff.

2. Groups must arrive prior to 10:00 PM.

3. Water is unavailable in Pine Ridge from October 15 - May 15.

4. One adult must accompany each 15 youths.

5. Alcohol is prohibited in the campground.

6. Your reservation and camp out can be canceled, if the area is too wet.

7. Camping fee is \$2.00 per person, per night, \$20.00 minimum.

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
